The Teachers' Gateway to Special Education website is designed to help SERTs and classroom teachers access and implement strategies for students with learning challenges.

The site is user friendly with easy access to strategies to address:

- Student Needs (Aggression Management, Attention Skills, Fine/Gross motor Skills, Social Skills, etc)
- Exceptionalities Determined by IPRC (Autism Spectrum Disorder, Developmental Disability, Giftedness, etc)
- Diagnosed Medical/Psychological Conditions (Asperger's Syndrome, Central Auditory Processing Disorders, Depression, Tourette Syndrome, etc)

On the site you will also find information and helpful hints on Special Education processes as well as a section to contribute your own strategies.

The Glossary of Terms is helpful for defining those often confusing acronyms and Special Education terms.
